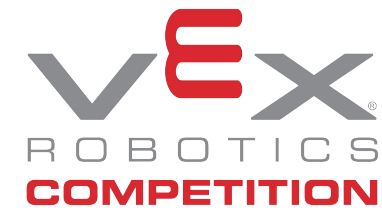

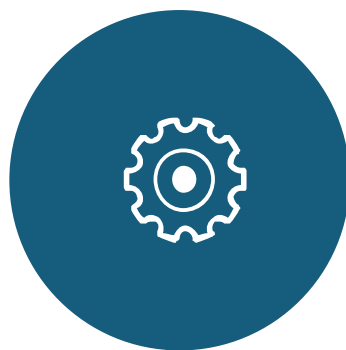

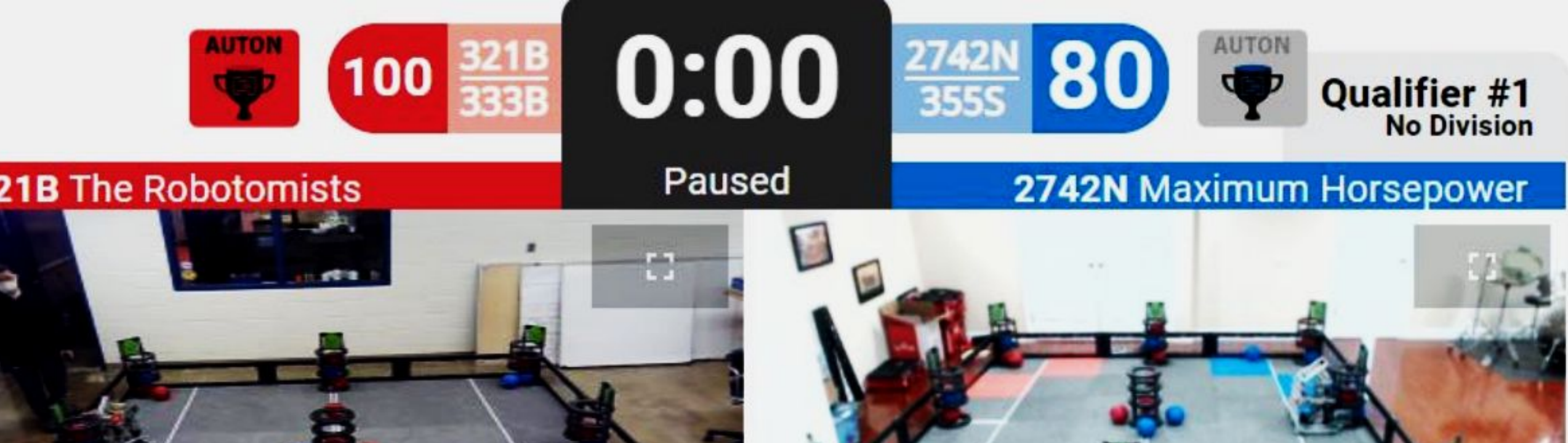

## Live Remote Tournaments **LRT**

Event Partner can implement an **Event Region Reserve Percentage**

Judging can qualify teams when

- Following organizational limits
- Team belongs to that event region

No Skills Option for LRT

LRT Ranking System



# Skills **Only**

## Legal again

Must be In-Person

Judging is permitted.

No awards qualify to another event (Champions & Judged Awards)

Must be posted by October 1

- ✓ Scores post to World Skills Standings
- ✓ World Skills Standings can be used to fill Championships
- ✗ No remote option





# Remote Judging

**Follow same rules as in-person judging**

All teams must get the opportunity to be interviewed

All Championships and Signature Events must include Judging
